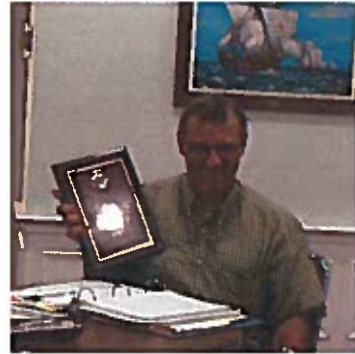
Newsletter Month: July, 2014
